Aputure Light Storm 1200d Pro

Over the years, Aputure has been building up its lighting lineup with fixtures that have high output and substantially better build quality. The Aputure Light Storm 1200d Pro is a flagship product from them. For many Aputure users, these new fixtures might look expensive but definitely a worthy try if you are looking for compact day light source which also can be nearest alternative for 1.2k / 1.8k HMI and Arri M18.

Besides power, control is a driving force in the design of the 1200d Pro. The light supports multiple wireless control methods, including the Sidus Link mobile app and the built-in wireless DMX control. The 1200d Pro is also compatible with LumenRadio CRMX, Art-net, and sACN via an etherCON connector. It also has 5-pin DMX512 connectivity for seamlessly integrating into any professional DMX interface.

It has four dimming curves: Linear, Exponential, Log, and S-Curve, to ensure accuracy regardless of your chosen brightness level. While you can make adjustments locally on the fixture, you can also make them wirelessly from a distance, and this is very useful when the light is mounted overhead or in hard-to-reach places.

The light is ready for worldwide use via its universal power supply. It also has two 48V/15A 3-pin XLR DC inputs supporting half or full power via various compatible battery options.

What is in the Box??

The LS 1200d Pro comes with a light, a control box, and three reflectors. This includes a rolling case for the 1200d Pro and a separate case for the other two reflectors. The complete kit is listed below.

Unlike the other Light Storm lights, the Light Storm 1200d Pro Ships with three new **Bowens Mount Hyper Reflectors** with varying beam angles. It comes in its own case, and the included case for the LS 1200d Pro has a slot available for one.

The narrow version has a pretty strong hot spot and improves with the Medium and Wide versions.

ACCESSORIES

There are many Bowens-S-Type accessories available from Aputure and various other brands like Chimera and DoPChoice. Despite this, know that not all accessories will work on the 1200d Pro, and not even all Aputure 1st party accessories are recommended for the 1200d Pro. For example, the Aputure Spotlight Mount wasn't designed for the 1200d Pro or even the 600d Pro but is intended for Light Storm 300 series fixtures. So, keep this in mind when considering accessories for the 1200d Pro beyond the hyper reflector attachments.

Perhaps sensing there might be a bit of confusion about compatible accessories, Aputure went ahead and released this chart that breaks down everything into optimized, compatible and 3rd party approved categories:
